<p>Canoe-Picnic Point State Park 36661 Cedar Point State Park Drive Clayton, NY 13624 (315) 654-2522</p> <p><i>Open during the summer</i></p>	<p>Canoe-Picnic Point State Park is only reachable by boat, offering a quiet camping experience in a wooded area with plenty of dock space available. Just south of the camping area is Picnic Point, a picnic ground with a beautiful picnic gazebo, shore dinner cooking facility and dockage</p>	<p>Located on the northeast end of Grindstone Island, facing Eel Bay and the Canadian Channel. Best access is from either Wellesley Island just over the Thousand Islands bridge or from Grass Point State Park on Rte 12, 1 mile south of the Thousand Islands Bridge</p>
<p>Higley Flow State Park 442 Cold Brook Drive Colton, NY 13625 (315) 262-2880</p> <p><i>Open from Memorial Day until Labor Day</i></p>	<p>Higley Flow State Park is nestled among the Adirondack foothills on the picturesque Raquette River. Spacious campsites, separated from neighbors by pine trees, abound in the park. The terrain is hilly and heavily-wooded and there is a sandy beach on the reservoir of the Raquette River. The scenic river is ideal for canoeing and fishing. The Beaver Pond Nature Trail has interpretive signs that describe the six distinct habitats through which the trail passes. Hiking trails double as cross-country ski trails in winter, when snowmobiling, snowshoeing and ice fishing are also allowed</p>	<p>Route 56 to South Colton. West on Cold Brook Drive</p>
<p>Macomb Reservation State Park 201 Campsite Road Schuyler Falls, NY 12985(518) 643-9952</p> <p><i>Opens in mid May and closes after Labor Day</i></p>	<p>Macomb Reservation State Park lies just outside the Adirondack Park along the Salmon River's course toward Lake Champlain. Surrounded by state land, the park has a wilderness atmosphere. Visitors can swim in man-made Davis Pond, use non-motorized boats and fish in the pond or the Salmon River. The park has playing fields, a picnic area, a self-guided nature trail, a hiking trail, electric and non-electric wooded campsites. Winter activities include ice skating, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and snowmobiling</p>	<p>I-87 to Route 22B. The park is 2 miles west of Schuyler Falls</p>
<p>Point Au Roche State Park 19 Camp Red Cloud Road Plattsburg, NY 12901 (518) 563-0369</p>	<p>Point Au Roche State Park, on the northwestern shore of Lake Champlain, is a mixture of open and forested areas, most of them natural and undeveloped. The park's large day-use area has a protected, sandy beach, picnic facilities</p>	<p>Located off Route 9, 6 miles north of Plattsburg</p>

	 <p>and concession stand. Boating and fishing are popular activities, as are volleyball, softball and other games. The park offers 60 designated mooring sites in Deep Bay. The staffed Nature Center offers a variety of programs open to the public all year. The park's trails, including nature, hiking and biking trails, wind through interesting habitats, from forest to marsh to shoreline. The trails are in use all year for school programs, nature hikes and cross-country skiing. The park also provides access for ice fishing</p>	
<p>Robert G. Wehle State Park 5502 Military Road Henderson, NY 13650 (315) 938-5083 (315) 846-5338</p>	<p>Robert G. Wehle State Park is the region's newest park. The former estate of Mr. Wehle, the park boasts 1,100 acres and over 17,000 ft of spectacular Lake Ontario shoreline. Among the facilities immediately available to the public is the residential compound featuring the main house, guest quarters, the "studio" and formal gardens. Extremely private, the area can accommodate up to 8 people. Rental arrangements can be made through the Wescott Beach State Park office. Also available are over 10 miles of hiking/mountain biking trails, tennis court, picnicking and cross-country skiing</p>	
<p><u>Robert Moses State Park - Thousand Islands</u> P.O. Box 548 Massena, NY 13662 (315) 769-8663</p>	<p>Robert Moses State Park is located partly on the mainland and partly on Barnhart Island. Visitors reach the park through a tunnel under the Eisenhower Lock. The park is spacious, home to a large variety of flora and fauna and offers a multitude of recreational opportunities, including wooded campsites and cabins, a marina and boat launch, some of the best fishing in the Northeast, picnic areas, a swimming beach, tennis courts and a year round nature center. The nature center also offers holiday, special events and school outreach programs. The park's nature, hiking and cross-country skiing trails wind through fields, forests and wetlands, with overlooks showcasing spectacular views. In winter, the park also welcomes snowmobilers</p>	<p>Located off Route 37, 3 miles north of Massena on the St. Lawrence River</p>
<p>Southwick Beach State Park 8119 Southwicks Place Henderson, NY 13650 (315) 846-5338</p>	<p>Southwick Beach State Park is spacious and popular, known for outstanding swimming and sunning on its long sandy beach. Campers and day-users enjoy picnicking, hiking and games on the playing fields. The park is adjacent to the</p>	<p>Located on the Lake Ontario shore, off Route 3, southwest of Watertown</p>

<p><i>Opens in early-May and operates through Columbus Day weekend</i></p>	<p>Lakeview Wildlife Management Area, home to the environmentally-sensitive coastal sand dunes. Park nature, hiking, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing trails adjoin the wildlife management area and its trail system, which visitors are encouraged to use. During the winter, snowmobilers are permitted in the park</p>	
<p><u>Wellesley Island State Park</u> 44927 Cross Island Road Fineview, NY 13640 (315) 482-2722</p>	<p>Wellesley Island State Park has the largest camping complex in the Thousand Islands region. Secluded wilderness sites nestled along the banks of the St. Lawrence River are accessible only by foot or boat. Within this rustic paradise, fishing is excellent--particularly for muskie in autumn. To accommodate boaters, the park has a full service marina and four boat launches. A sandy beach on the river offers great swimming and sunbathing and there is a recreation barn and 9-hole golf course on the Island. One of the main attractions of the park is the Minna Anthony Common Nature Center, which includes a museum, varied habitats such as wooded wetlands, 3 miles of shoreline and open granite outcrops, and miles of trails for hiking, cross-country skiing and nature education</p>	<p>Route 81 to exit 51, (the Thousand Islands International Bridge) cross the bridge to park entrance</p>
<p>Westcott Beach State Park P.O. Box 339 Sackets Harbor, NY 13685(315) 646-2239</p> <p><i>Open from early-May through Columbus Day</i></p>	<p>Westcott Beach State Park is a popular day-use and camping park on Lake Ontario, with rolling, wooded hills and open, grassy meadows sheltered by Henderson Bay. It offers restful campsites located on a bluff, from which the view is spectacular. A small marina is adjacent to the long, sandy beach to accommodate anglers interested in Lake Ontario's excellent black bass fishing. The park also has a children's playground, picnic areas and hiking trails that do winter duty for cross-country skiing</p>	<p>Located off Route 3, 3 miles west of Sackets Harbor at Henderson Bay</p>
<p>Whetstone Gulf State Park RD #2, Box 69 Lowville, NY 13367 (315) 376-6630</p> <p><i>Open from Memorial Day through mid September and from December 15 through March 15</i></p>	<p>Whetstone Gulf State Park is built in and around a three-mile-long gorge cut into the eastern edge of the Tug Hill Plateau. The gorge is one of the most spectacular scenic vistas east of the Rocky Mountains. The park has 56 wooded campsites some of which are electric, a scenic picnic area along Whetstone Creek, a man-made swimming area and trails for hiking and cross-country skiing, one of which circles the gorge. Above the gorge is Whetstone Reservoir, stocked with tiger muskie and large-mouth bass for fishermen, and popular for canoeing</p>	<p>Located off Route 26, 6 miles south of Lowville, near the Adirondack Park</p>
